## PROPOSED AMENDMENT ACTION

The proposed Amendments were unanimously approved at our Special Meeting on December 1st and have been submitted to the WI Amendments and Recommendations Committee. The proposed Amendments now go to the International Study & Research Committee to be put in the proper wording and format. They are then sent to the State President who will send them to all state chapters for a vote. If approved by 2/3 of the local chapters, the Amendments will be presented for vote at the next state convention in June 2022.
