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STANDING RULES OF CHAPTER BL

1. Meetings of Chapter BL will start at 1 pm unless a change is made for a particular meeting. Luncheon typically starts at 11:45 am unless otherwise noted.
2. A gavel guard will be given to the president at the beginning of her term of office, if desired.
3. Committee chairs should prepare a short report each year to allow future chairs to become familiar with committee goals, activities and experience. Co-chairs may be appointed for larger committees.
4. The President's expenses for convention will be paid by the Chapter as will the expenses of the alternate/one other member.
5. The desired term of office will be two years.
6. Choice of Chapter fundraising projects is the responsibility of the Ways and Means Committee.
7. The President is not expected to serve the Chapter in other ways during her term of office, except as assigned by the board.
8. The complete Chapter BL e-mail list will be used only for Chapter business.
9. The Treasurer may pay bills submitted in the summer with approval of the President without a vote of the membership.
10. When addressing the Chapter, members will stand when possible to allow everyone to hear.

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11. These standing rules may be amended by a two-thirds vote, without previous notice or by majority vote with notice. A standing rule shall be adopted or suspended by a majority vote. A vote to suspend applies only to the meeting at which the vote is taken.

SUGGESTED TRADITIONS OF CHAPTER BL

The Courtesy Committee may adhere to these suggestions when extending a courtesy to a sister and/or her family.

1. A thoughtful remembrance such as a single yellow rose or other appropriate gift is to be given to members who are hospitalized or otherwise confined.
2. A gift will be given to a member in celebration of a special occasion, such as her wedding or birth of her baby.
3. When a member's daughter is married, a gift for the daughter will be presented.
4. A social coffee and a marguerite guard, or substitute remembrance, will be given when a member moves out of town.
5. At the death of a member, help will be offered at home, if needed. A note will be sent to a member's family. Individual contributions in the deceased member's memory will be collected at a chapter meeting for her favorite P.E.O. Project. No public mention will be made as to the total amount of money collected.
